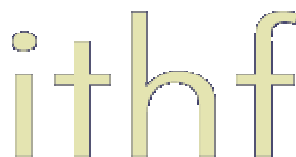


Introduction

- Today's peace doctrine of the church
- The problems of peace enforcement illustrated by certain actual conflicts
